BRISTOL PUBLIC WORKS-WORKSHOPS SCHEDULED FOR JUNE

The Public Works Department continues its educational informational sessions in June. This month, residents can learn about recycling and composting in an effort to decrease the amount of waste at the Transfer Station.

Based on the increasing costs and significant global changes affecting recycling, the City of Bristol's Public Works Department is hosting a "**Recycling 101 Workshop**" on June 27 from 6:30pm-7:30pm.

Sherill Baldwin from CT DEEP will be presenting attendees with an update on what does and doesn't go into the blue recycle bins.

With the recent success of the Composting Workshop, Alastair Ong of UConn Extension Master Gardner Center will make a return appearance to lead the workshop on worm composting bins. "If you're just starting out as a worm farmer, this is the workshop for you", stated Lindsey Rivers, Public Works Analyst.
