### **HEATWAVE-COOLING STATIONS-UPDATED FOR WEEKEND EXTREME HEAT**

The temperature this weekend will be oppressive with extremely high heat and humidity. Below are cooling stations for those needing to get away from the heat. As a reminder kindly check on family and/or elderly neighbors. Keep hydrated and remember, animals shouldn't be left outside in the heat, or in vehicles.

#### COOLING STATIONS:

The Bristol Public Library-Main Branch at 5 High Street Thursday, 8:30-8:00pm and Friday 8:30am-5:00pm. It will also be open Sunday, July 21, 2019 from 1pm-5pm to accommodate people looking to escape the heat. In addition, full services will be available, including computers and internet access, children's play areas along with reading rooms.

The Bristol Senior Center -240 Stafford Avenue is open weekdays as a Cooling Center, Monday thru Friday 8:30am-5:00pm. *Closed Saturday and Sunday.*

Community Health Center -395 North Main Street is open Thursday 8am-5pm; Friday 8:30am-5pm and Saturday 8:30am to 12pm (noon). *Closed Sunday*

The Salvation Army - Bristol, CT is open week days, Monday thru Friday from 9am-2pm. *Closed Saturday/Sunday*

The Agape House -43 School St. is open every day except Sunday from 8am-Noon.

Brian's Angels –located at St. Vincent DePaul, 19 Jacob St., is open every day from 1pm-5pm

The following businesses have graciously offered their establishments as a way to escape the heat. Please be respectful of patrons. Dunkin Donuts, Price Chopper and Starbucks.
