BRISTOL, CONN., (September 17, 2019) – The City of Bristol Department of Public Works along with the Bristol Public Library will be hosting a FREE Community Shred Day at the Bristol Farmers Market on Saturday, September 28, 2019. The event will take place during the hours of 9 am and 12 pm and shredding will be provided by FileShred of Glastonbury, Conn.

The public is urged to bring up to ten boxes of household paper to this event to be shred for FREE. Taking the time to shred documents will offer you peace of mind in knowing that your materials have been eliminated without adding the worry that an identity thief might find them later on. Secure on-site destruction of paper records will help you protect your identity – documents include tax returns, bank statements, utility bills, and medical records, to name a few.

This shredding event will not only help the community become more aware of the importance of identity protection, but will also help protect the environment. All of the documents and files that will be destroyed at this event will be recycled by FileShred. The recycled paper will be used to make other paper products and reduce the need to harvest trees.
