ROUTE 6 MILLING AND RESURFACING PROJECT TO BEGIN IN JUNE

(BRISTOL, CT) – The Connecticut Department of Transportation will be paving a section of Route 6 starting on or about Thursday, June 11 2020 and is scheduled to be completed by Friday, June 19, 2020. The 1.86 mile night construction project will start at the Plymouth town line and end at Sherman Street in Bristol.

“We like to give notice on these projects so residents can anticipate the delays and one lane alternating traffic and adjust their schedules accordingly,” said Councilman David Preleski who represents the Second District where the work is being proposed. Traffic control personnel and signing patterns will be utilized. The regular work schedule for this project is 7pm to 5am (Sunday through Thursday).

“We also want to remind people that there may be changes to the schedule due to weather delays or other unforeseen conditions, said Councilman Peter Kelley, who also represents the Second District. He also advised residents to maintain a safe speed when driving in the vicinity to ensure the safety of the workers and other drivers.
