BRISTOL ANNOUNCES 2020 SUMMER PAVING PROGRAM

BRISTOL, CT) – The City of Bristol's Public Works Department has released its schedule for the 2020 summer paving program which will be completed in two phases. "The initial phase consists of milling off the existing bituminous pavement of the road. The second phase consists of installing a new bituminous roadway surface and will start shortly after the first phase," said City Engineer Nancy Levesque. "Once construction is complete, the City will repair any affected driveway aprons."

The 2020 summer roadway resurfacing program begins on July 6, 2020. As part of the program, the following streets will be milled and then resurfaced:

Brewster Road (Queen to Rotary)	Magnolia Avenue
Geary Avenue	Vanderbilt Rd.
Round Hill Rd.	Rogers Rd.
Main Street (South St. to Blvd)	Redstone Street
Tulip Street (Park to Divinity)	Willow Brook Rd.

"There may be minor traffic delays during construction, however roads will remain open for mail delivery, emergency vehicles, and local traffic at all times," said Mayor Ellen Zoppo-Sassu. "Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted as needed during construction."
