CITY OF BRISTOL FIRE DEPARTMENT MEMBERS SEEK DONATIONS FOR 9/11 MEMORIAL & RESTORATION TO LOCAL MONUMENT

As the 20th anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks approaches, the Bristol Firefighters are in the planning stages on a project to restore a local monument.

The Fire Headquarters monument section is located on the corner of North Main and Center Streets and recognizes the International Association of Firefighters (IAFF) as well as the Fallen Firefighters memorial. The project will include a 9/11 Monument, an IAFF Monument, restoration of the existing Bristol Fallen Firefighters Monument and will include hardscapes, landscaping and lighting.

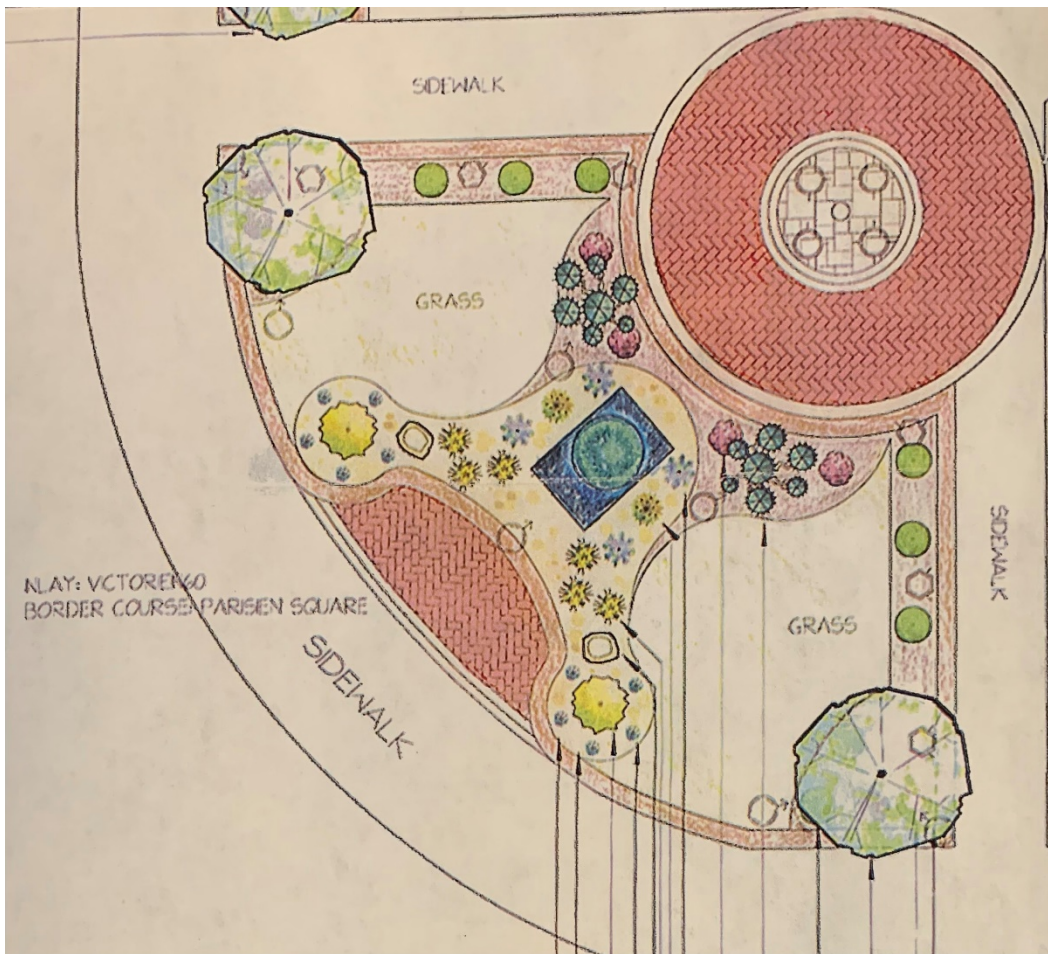
