### ***BRISTOL ANNOUNCES 2021 FALL PAVING PROGRAM***

(BRISTOL, CT) – The City of Bristol's Public Works Department has released its schedule for the 2021 fall paving program which will be completed in two phases. "The initial phase consists of milling off the existing pavement of the road," said Public Works Director Raymond Rogozinski. "The second phase consists of installing a new roadway surface and will commence shortly after the first phase. Once construction is complete, the City will repair any affected driveway aprons."

The 2021 fall roadway paving program begins on August 31 or September 1 and will be completed by the fall. The following streets will be milled and then paved:
