(BRISTOL, CT October 26, 2021) – The City of Bristol invites the community to visit the final regular season Farmers Market which will take place at Centre Square in downtown Bristol on Saturday, October 30 from 10 am until 1 pm. And as a reminder, the community can safely dispose of their unwanted electronics at the Farmers Market one last time for this year on Saturday. Community volunteers will be on hand from 10 am until 1 pm to assist with items that are dropped off. Electronics recycling services are being provided by Take2 Secure Electronics Recycling. Items that can be dropped off include: computers, tablets, cell phones, printers, keyboards, computer monitors, laptops, cameras, TVs, and video game consoles. Parking and the entrance to the market is accessible from Hope Street.

In addition to being an authorized SNAP/EBT farmers market, the City of Bristol Farmers Market is recognized by the Connecticut Department of Agriculture as accepting payment vouchers from the Women, Infants, and Children Farmers Market Nutrition Program and Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program. All participating farms are certified by the Connecticut Department of Agriculture.
