A Community Shred Day Will Be Held on Saturday, October 1, 2022

(BRISTOL, CT September 26, 2022) – A Community Shred Day Event will be held adjacent to the Farmers Market at Centre Square on Saturday, October 1st from 9 am until 12 pm (or until the truck is full). The community is encouraged to bring up to four boxes of household paper to be shred for FREE.

The City of Bristol Public Works Department is partnering with the Bristol Public Library to help the community protect their identity by offering this free service which will be provided by FileShred of Glastonbury. Volunteers will be on site to assist and unload boxes from your vehicle.


“This is a great way for the community to get rid of household paperwork that may contain personal information. All documents will be securely destroyed on site,” stated Lindsey Rivers, Public Works Analyst for the City of Bristol.
