### **The Mum Festival and Parade Returns September 23rd through the 25th**

(BRISTOL, CT: September 20, 2022) – Mum Festival will be celebrating its 60th year as Bristol’s fall marquee event and will return to Memorial Boulevard on September 23<sup>rd</sup> through the 25th. The Bristol Exchange Club and the Mum Festival Committee are proud and excited to announce that this year’s parade theme will be “Celebrating 60 Years of Flower Power.”

As part of this year’s epic Mum Festival events, Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup> at 1:30 pm will once again feature the historic Mum Festival Parade – a long-time tradition of the Festival.

The community is advised that there will be road closures throughout the weekend and is asked to please plan accordingly. The Memorial Boulevard and all streets connected to the Boulevard – Mellen Street and Wozenski Way – will be closed from Friday, September 23, 2022 beginning at 1 pm for the Mum Festival until Sunday, September 25, 2022 to approximately 10 pm.

On Sunday, September 25, 2022 at 1 pm, the Mum Festival parade will take place in the downtown area. The following areas and their intersecting streets will be affected:

- South Street
- North Main Street
- Main Street
- West Street
- Race Street
- Riverside Avenue extension

Detours will be posted to help guide motorists around the affected areas. The parade is expected to end at 4pm.
